MADRID, May 16, 1870.
In the Constituent Cortes on Saturday a repub-

lican Deputy made a speech, wherein he spoke of the insurrection as still existing in Cub1, notwithstanding the repeated statements on the part of the government that it had terminated. Schor More, the Minister for the Colonies, replied

at some length, persisting that the insurrection was really ended. There were predatory bands of insurgents still in Guba, and some skirmishes had lately occurred, but entire order would soon be restored.
