SPAIN. War Despatches from Cuba-Revolutionists Surrender.

Madrid, June 2, 1870.

Despatches have been received at the Colonial Ministry from Captain General Rodas, informing the government that insurgent generals in Cuba offer to surrender on the condition that their lives and

property be spared, and asking for instructions as to the course to pursue.

The government has replied by telegraph that it is their desire that rebel officers sincerely desiring to either until contest and to be reconciled to Spain be

dealt with generously.
