Curlos Garcia Honorably Discharged—Operations Suspended in Laying the West India Cable. HAVANA. July 23, 1870.

Carlos Garcia, formerly a shipping merchant, who was accused of defrauding the United States government, has been honorably discharged by the Supreme Court.

The Panama and West India Cable Company's steamer Sufoik ran aground in Los-Gerdas channel yesterday' but soon after floated.

The operations of the company have been suspended until the Spanish gunboats can sound out a

deeper channel.
