CUSA. How the Fourth of July was Celebrated. HAYANA, July 5, 1870. The Americans here colebrated the Fourth of July

by a dinner, at which, for the first time since the late rebellion, Northern and Southern men met in this city on a convivial occasion. The hand of the vounteers farmished the music. Speeches were made by the Consul General and others, and great good feeling prevaited. The rooms were decorated with American flags, and in front of the building

hung the Spanish and American banners.
