Kindness Shown the Wife of Cespedes in Havana — Courts-Martial Abolished, Except for Treason, and Rebellion and Sedition.

HAVANA, Jan. 11.—Anitas, the wife of President CESPEDES, speaks in the highest terms of the gentlemanly and kind treatment she has received at the hands of the Spaniards since her capture. She says that she left her husband in the interior several days previous to her capture on the coast, where she was awaiting a vessel on which to embark and leave the island. Zenca, who acted as the escort of the wife of President Cespedes, and the two sailors who were captured at the same time, were taken to Puerto Principe. Senora CES-PEDES is about twenty years of age, has a pleasant-looking face, is affable in conversation, and is a fair type of the women of the Camaguey region. She is now, however, in delicate health. VALMASEDA, the acting Governor-General of the island, has issued an order abolishing Courts-martial for the trials of causes other than those of treason, rebellion and sedition. The civil Courts are given jurisdiction over oftenders against the laws, where the crime is not included in those specified.
