### **Landing of a Small Filibuster Expedition—Remington Rifles Captured.**

HAVANA, Jan. 23.—Information has been received here of the landing of ten filibusters at Rio de la Palma, in the Vuelta-Abojo region. Two of the men were captured; also, a boat containing forty-eight Remington guns and copies of a proclamation signed by QUESADA.

### **Details of the Latest Expedition—Quesada's Proclamation in Full—A Schooner Loading with Arms at Nassau—Mourning for Prim—Abstracting Drafts from the Mail.**

HAVANA, Jan. 23.—The filibusters captured at Rio de la Palma came in a schooner from New-York. Two of them were killed. Eight remain, with the leader, FELIPE RIVERA. Volunteer citizens are pursuing the rest of them. The capture of the boat and arms is confirmed. The proclamation of QUESADA to the people of Vuelta Abajo says:

“I send you what you asked for. Your opportunity to break your yoke will have come when I disembark a powerful expedition somewhere, and send you arms and ammunition. Your brothers in the Eastern Department began with less, and whipped their enemies. To arms, and war against a cowardly Spanish assassin.”

It is signed “Quesada,” but has no date or place attached to the document. No importance is given here to the landing of these filibusters. .... A letter from Nassau, dated the 13th instant, announces that the schooner *Eastern Queen* is loading with arms and ammunition, ostensibly for San. Domingo.... The English brig *Leona* ran into the English brig *Frank*, from Cienfuegos for Halifax, loaded with molasses, off Matanzas. The *Frank* was sunk, but the crew were saved. The *Leona* was damaged and leaking.... For three days the bells will toll and the guns of the fort be fired in memory of PRIM.... ANTONIO GIRAL, a post-office employe, has been arrested, charged with being accessory to the collection of drafts that had been abstracted from the mails.
