CUBA.

Destruction of a Railroad Bridge by Insurgents—An Engagement With 700 Cubans in Moron—Defeat of the Insurgents—Quesada's Expedition.

HAVANA, Feb. 21.—The insurgents have destroyed the Enomitano Railroad Bridge, between Santiago de Cuba and Villa del Cobre. An ougagement of some importance has taken place at Manacas del Abragrande, in the Jurisdiction of Moron, between 600 or 700 insurgents commanded by Boitel. The insurgents were defeated, and had tifteen killed. The Spaniards had two killed. The insurgents were awaiting the arrival of SALOME HERNANDEZ, with 400 men and one cannon, from Camaguay, with the purpose of attacking isolated Spanish detachments and protecting the disembarking of the Quesada expedition. No expedition has landed at Vuelta-Abaio.

Earthquake Shocks at Santiago and Trinidad de Cuba.

HAVANA, Feb. 21.—A dispatch from Santiago de Cuba, received today, states that several shocks of earthquake were felt there yesterday and today, but no damage was done. Shocks of earthquake were felt at Trinidad de Cuba last week.
