## WEST INDIES.

Official Change in Cuba—A British Manof-War Ashore in Jamaica—The Commander Court-Martialed for Neglect.

HAVANA, April 19.—Antonio Ceballino, the newly appointed Segundo Gabo: of the island, arrived from Spain yesterday. Gen. Carbo, whom Ceballinossucceeds, will surrender his command to-morrow, and will leave for Spain on the 30th. The retiring General had obtained the sympathy of the public to a great degree, and all parties and classes regret his departure.

Kingston, Jamaica, April 19.—The English war-steamer Immortality is ashore on a mudbank in the harbor. Other war vessels and 2,000 sailors were unsuccessful in their efforts to remove her guns. The rigging, however, was removed, and placed on board of lighters. The Commander was tried by court-martial on a charge of negligence. The Pay-master of the Immortality yesterday fell out of a window and was killed.
