Caban Officials—Anxiety Regarding the Steamer Port-au-Prince — Capital of Jamaica to be Changed.

HAVANA, July 7.—VALMAS EDA 18 at Sancti Espiritus: Cebollino is sick with vomito, and Venence is the Acting Captain-General. Advices from Hayti to the 8th, state that fears were entertained for the safety of the steamer Port-au-Prince from New-York. was then sixteen days overdue. Advices from Jamaica to the 6th, state that in two months the seat of Government will be removed from Spanish Town to Kingston. Lumber and shingles are much wanted. It is reported that the Government will not continue the arrangement with the Pacific wall steamers. The Rising Star will sail for New-York on the 7th. Commander SELF-RIDGE and other exploring officers are among Der passengers.
