The administrator and part owner of the sugar estate called Sacramento, near Aquacaste, on the Rigia Railroad, was murdered by three coolies working in the plantation chain gang. One of them had complained of sickness, when the administrator replied that he should have reported it the night before so that he might have been detached from the chain gang. This reply aroused the coolies,

and they struck the administrator down with their machetes and backed him to pieces.
