Boundaries

OF THE SEVERAL WARDS OF THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE.

SECTION 1.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Councilmen of the City of Louisville, that the City of Louisville shall be, and is hereby divided into two Districts, to be called the Eastern and Western District, and that the Eastern District shall include and extend from the western line of Third street to the eastern limits of the city, and the Western District shall extend from said western line of Third street to the western limits of the city.

SECTION 2.

That the City shall be and is hereby divided into eight Wards, and that the

First Ward shall be all that part of the city lying eastwardly of the central line of Hancock street.

Second Ward shall be that part of the city bounded as follows: Beginning at the river in the central line of Hancock street, thence down the river to the central line of Preston street, thence with said central line to the central line of Jefferson street; thence with the same to the central line of Jefferson street, thence with the same to the central line of Floyd street, thence with the same, and the same line continued southwardly to the city limits, thence with the city limits to the central line of Hancock street, thence with the same to the beginning.

Third Ward shall be that part of the city lying between the central line of First street, and the lower or westwardly line of the Second Ward, as just described.

Fourth Ward shall be that part of the city lying between the central line of First street and the central line of Third street.

Fifth Ward shall be that part of the city lying between the central line of Third street and the central line of Fifth street.

Sixth Ward shall be that part of the city lying between the central line of Fifth street and the central line of Seventh street.

Seventh Ward shall be that part of the city lying between the central line of Seventh and the central line of Tenth streets.

Eighth Ward shall be all that part of the city lying westwardly of the central line of Tenth street.

SECTION 3.

That this ordinance shall be and continue in force from the first Monday in May, 1845, inclusive, to the first Monday in May, 1850, inclusive, and that all ordinances contrary to this be and are hereby repealed.

PUBLIC BUILDINGS.

THE CITY HALL AND COURT-HOUSE.

The design of this splendid edifice originated with Mr. Shyrock, and was erected under his supervision. Its unfinished state deprives us of the splendor of appearance which it would possess were it complete. The money thus far expended for its erection amounts to upwards of \$280,000 and it is supposed that \$150,000 more will be required for its completion. It affords a separate room for the City Council, City Court, County Court Criminal, Circuit, and Chancery Courts, on the first and second floors. The third floor has been used for public speaking, and as an arsenal and drill room for our volunteer military companies.

KENTUCKY INSTITUTION FOR THE EDUCATION OF THE BLIND.

On Broadway, between First and Second Streets.

This institution was established by the General Assembly of Kentucky in 1842, and it is certainly a magnificent edifice. It gives to all the blind youth of Kentucky a home and the means of moral and intellectual improvement. The course of instruction embraces the elementary and higher English branches, ancient and modern languages, and vocal and instrumental music. The pupils are also instructed in various kinds of handicraft, by which they will be enabled to gain an honorable support after leaving the institution. The indigent children of the State are educated at the expense of the institution, paying pupils are charged a moderate price. Applicants are required to present a certificate of incurable blindness, of freedom from disease, and of unexceptionable moral character.

CITY AND COUNTY JAIL.

This structure is built in a recent and tasteful style, consonant with the character of the building. It is of Gothic architecture, was drafted by Mr. John Jeffrey, and erected under his superintendence. The interior is fitted up with neat cells, 48 in number, with everything which can conduce to the health of the inmates.

MARINE HOSPITAL.

This building is situated in the southeastern part of the city, commanding an extensive view. The expense for the erection of this institution was defrayed by donations, &c., from different sources. The State has endowed it with \$40,000, and the city pays \$500 per annum for the privilege of sending her infirm to it for restoration.
