3 Cubans Held In Arms Plot

Three Cuban nationals arrested here yesterday with 15 guns and 500 rounds of ammunition were to be arraigned today on charges of trying to make an illegal arms shipment to Cuba.

Customs Agent W. B. Lankford said the 14 carbines and one sawed-off shotgun taken from the three men were believed destined for Cuba for use in an uprising against the Batista government.

Lankford identified the men as Eugenio R. Garcia, 43; Eduardo Garcia, 31, and Evelio Prieto, 29. He said they were arrested as they loaded the guns and ammunition into a car at La Rumba, a Spanish-American club at 2395 SW 8th St.
