American Democratic Union, l which altegedly replaced the caribbean legion, for the purpose of inciting revolutions in Cuba, Guatemala and Nicaragua. Other alleged heads of the Cen-

tral American Democratic union are former Guatemalan President Juan Jose Arevalo and Nicaraguan Juan Jose Meza Amador. This is the third conspiracy against the Cuban government un-

covered here in the past few months. The first one in June of this year was foiled when Federal agents arrested a group of Cubans headed by Fidel Castro Ruz who were undergoing commando

training in a ranch near Mexico Cily. Castro Ruz Is the head of the revolutionary "July 26" group Sometime later three Cubans were accested in Merida and some arms were also confiscated. It
