revolutionary Dr. Fidel Castro Ruz reaffirmed his promise of "liberty of death in 1956" today and advised Cuban dictator Fulgencio Batista that he has only two weeks to form a new "government of national unity."

"If Batista fails to act he willing have set the hour of his downfalt," Castro Ruz said.

The leader of the Cuban "26 of July revolutionaries" has been in hiding here from a reported roundup of Cuban. Guatemalan and Nicaraguan exiles in Mexico.

But he told life United Press today that Batista will have a revolution on his hands if he refuses to offer a solution before Dominican Republic strongman Rafael Trujillo culminates his own "plans of agression" against Cuba.

Castro Ruz stressed the independence of his revolutionaries from Trujillo and said "we are enemies

Although there is no order out for his arrest, pelice said Castro Ruz has not been seen in any of the places frequented by revolutionaries since the government started a new crackdown last week on exiles suspected of plotting against their governments.
