Dear Alvin:

I spoke to Mike last night. The Government asked for another extension of 30 days to present the "writ of certiorari".

The judge has not made a ruling on the bail motion yet. If he doesn't decide this week I'll be thinking about an order of "mandamus". However, I feel that he'll give an answer this week, since perhaps - one of the reasons why he has not ruled was that he was waiting for the Government's decision as to whether they were going to appeal to the Supreme Court or not.

As you recall, he did say in Court that he was not going to wait for the Government to decide about the appeal - to make his decision. Nevertheless he has waited for a month. But I'll be inclined to believe that he's not very satisfied with the Government's request to the Supreme Court - for another 30 days.

Tomorrow or the day after I'll be sending you a copy of Congressman's Daniel B. Crane speech at the "26th. Conference of APACT (Asian People's

Anti-Communist League), held in Perth, Western Australia between Nov. 17-19, 1980.

His speech deals with Orlando Petekier's activities as a KGB agent and the subversive activities of IPS against the U.S. - It's very favorable to us.
