Eleven lifts

Thirty-five latent fingerprints and five latent impressions (which are either finger or palm prints) of value are present or were developed on the specimens as follows:

- Four fingerprints and two impressions on lifts designated 1, 2, 6, 8 and 9 from 1971 Volvo
- Four fingerprints on mirror from sun visor (three also on lifts 10 and 11 from mirror)
- One fingerprint on letter opener, part of K96
- One fingerprint on pamphlet, part of K98

Two fingerprints on yellow pad, part of K98  
Twenty-three fingerprints and three impressions  
on items designated as part of K109

No latent prints of value were present or  
developed on the remaining specimens.

Four latent fingerprints developed on the  
following specimens have been identified as finger  
impressions of Virgilio Pablo Paz Romero, born 11-20-51  
in Cuba, as follows:

One on letter opener, part of K96  
One on "ESTES" pamphlet, part of K98  
Two on yellow pad, part of K98

The remaining unidentified latent prints are  
not identical with major case prints of Guillermo Novo  
Sampol, FBI #92112G; Alvin Diaz Ross, born 11-27-32 in  
Cuba; or Ignacio Robert Novo, FBI #92257G. The  
unidentified latent fingerprints are not identical with  
fingerprints of Dionisio Suarez Esquivel, FBI #264663E,  
or Paz Romero. The latent impressions were compared,  
insofar as possible, with available fingerprints of  
Suarez Esquivel and Paz Romero, but no identification  
was effected. Major case prints of these two individuals  
are needed for conclusive comparisons.

Based on the information furnished, no  
fingerprints were located here for William Machado or  
Michael Vernon Townley.

The lifts of no value were destroyed.

You will receive a separate report setting  
forth the results of the laboratory examinations and  
the disposition of the submitted specimens.
