

The Colfax, La., Massacre—Flight of the Postmaster—The Office Discontinued.

WASHINGTON. April 28.—The Postmaster of Colfax, La., informs the Post-office Department that he was compelled to flee for his life at the recent massacre of colored men there, and that he took to Alexandria all the records and papers belonging to his office. He declines to serve any longer as Postmaster, and the Department has issued orders discontinuing the office at Colfax. The annual compensation of the Postmaster was \$12 only.
