The records of the Department of the Army ~~of the Department of the Army~~ show that Emilio F. Cabada entered into contract as acting assistant surgeon, ^{with troops} United States Army, on February 9, 1899. He was on duty at Cienfuegos, Santa Clara, Banos, and Gilara, Cuba; Fort Brown and Galveston, Texas; Fort Wingate, New Mexico, and at Denver, Colorado. This contract was annulled March 15, 1900.

Dr. Cabada again entered into contract as acting assistant surgeon, United States Army, March 16, 1900. He sailed from the United States March 17, 1900; and arrived in the Philippine Islands April 15, 1900. He was in arrest at Quingua, Philippine Islands, October 17, 1901, for drunkenness, and was released October 18, 1901. Dr. Cabada ~~was~~ ^{was} relieved from the Department of Northern Luzon for drunkenness, theft of Government whiskey, and neglect of duty, ~~(Special Orders No. 294, paragraph 5, Headquarters, Division of the Philippines, dated November 12, 1901).~~ He left Quingua December 1, 1901; sailed from the Philippine Islands December 11, 1902, and arrived in the United States January 9, 1902. Special Orders No. 13, Headquarters, Department of California, dated January 18, 1902, ordered him home to Cienfuegos, and upon arrival to report by letter to the Surgeon General, United States Army, for annulment of his contract. This contract was annulled January 19, 1902.

According to documents in his file, Dr. Emilio F. Cabada was born at Cienfuegos, Cuba in 1866 or 1867 and was single during his service. His next of kin is shown as his father, Emilio Fernandez Cabada, Cienfuegos. He was a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania and was a lieutenant colonel in the Cuban Army from 1896 to 1899.

Contract surgeons (also known as acting assistant surgeons) before the passage of the Act of Congress approved June 3, 1916, were neither soldiers or commissioned officers of the Army. They were not in the military service either by enlistment or commission and therefore formed no part of the military forces. They performed medical service under contract with the United States as civilians only and were not required to be either mustered in or out of the military service.

When the services of a contract surgeon were terminated by annulment of the contract, the annulment entered on the contract, though not technically an honorable discharge from the military service is, in effect, the same provided the contract was terminated under honorable conditions.

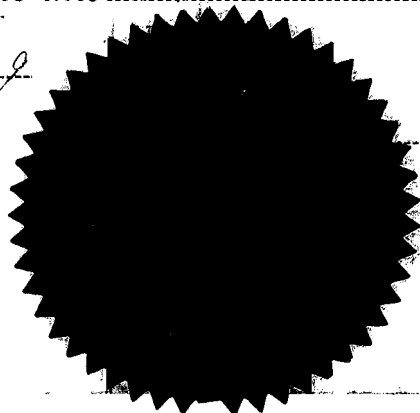

**CONTRACT with a Private Physician for service as a Contract Surgeon,
U. S. Army.**

This contract, entered into this 22nd day of February, 1897, at Cienfuegos in the ^{Department} State of Santa Clara, between J. H. Russell Major, Chief Surgeon, U.S.A., of the United States Army, and Dr. Emilio F. Cabada, of Cienfuegos, in the ^{Department} State of Santa Clara, witnesseth: that for the consideration hereinafter mentioned the said Dr. Emilio F. Cabada promises and agrees to perform the duties of a medical officer, agreeably to Army Regulations, and the said J. H. Russell Chief Surgeon Department of Santa Clara Province promises and agrees, on behalf of the United States, to pay, or cause to be paid, to the said Dr. Emilio F. Cabada, the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars for each and every month he shall continue to perform the services above stated. When on duty at a post or station where there are public quarters belonging to the United States, he shall receive the quarters in kind allowed by law to an Assistant Surgeon of the rank of First Lieutenant; and, when traveling under orders, the traveling allowances prescribed by laws and regulations in force for the time. And it is furthermore agreed, that at the expiration of his term of service, the said Dr. Emilio F. Cabada shall receive the traveling allowances, as aforesaid, for actual travel only, to the place of making the contract; provided said contract is not annulled for misconduct or neglect of duty, in which case no traveling allowances will be furnished. All of which shall be his full compensation, and in lieu of all allowances and emoluments. This contract to continue at least One month, if not sooner determined by the Surgeon General of the Army, or the Chief Surgeon of a Military Department or Army in the field.

It is furthermore expressly agreed and understood that, in conformity to the requirements of Section 3741 of the Revised Statutes, no member of, or delegate to, Congress shall be admitted to any share or part in this contract, or to any benefit to arise therefrom.

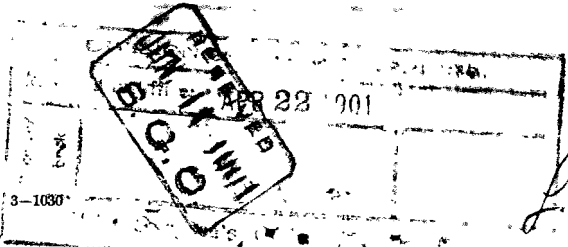
