

MAN DROWNED. A negro, probably a deserter from the Long Island camp, was found drowned in the water between the Fitchburg Railroad and Warren bridges, in Charlestown, this forenoon. He had evidently been in the water but a short time, and his dress consisted chiefly of a blue flannel shirt and a pair of gray pants. His body was recovered and taken to the Fitchburg Engine House and viewed by coroner John S. Dearborn, who deemed an inquest unnecessary.
