Airline Workers Call Off Strike After Seeing Prío

President Prio has appointed a commission composed of the Ministers of the Treasury, Labor and Communications and representatives of the National Federation of Aviation Workers and the Cuban Confederation of La-

bor to study elimination of private commercial use of the military airport at Camp Columbia, wherefore an assembly of airline workers will call off the scheduled strike of July 16, a group of aviation labor leaders reported yesterday, after a conference with the President. They said they had explained to the President their objections to use of the militar airporyt by commercial airlines, which include unfair competition, violation of labor laws and non-pay ment of landing dues, and that the President had agreed with their point of view.
