The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A loose signed photograph of the applicant must accompany the application.

The photographs must be on thin paper, should have a light background and be not over three inches in size.

Fee for passport, one dollar. Fee for executing application, one dollar.

A woman's application must state whether she is married or not, and a married woman must prove that her husband is a native citizen.
