F.B.I. Enters Case

The Federal Bureau of Investigation said it was investigating the murder of a Cuban refugee leader, Eulalio José Negrín, "to determine whether there was a Federal civil rights violation" in the shooting. Mr. Negrín, 38 years old, was shot Sunday near his home in Union City, N.J., and responsibility for the crime was assumed by an anonymous caller for the anti-Castro terrorist group Omega-7.

Several members of the Cuban-American community from Washington, Puerto Rico and New Jersey met with Federal officials in Washington to 'urge the establishment of a task force to investigate terrorist acts by Cuban organizations in the United States.
