SUBJECT: Membership of the Confederation of Cuban Workers (CTC).

There is attached as an unclassified enclosure to this despatch a list of the national industrial federations making up the Confederación de Trabajadores Cubanos (CTC) and of the number of component unions and individual members in each federation.

This list was given to the Embassy by the International Department of the CTC. The Department said the list is made up from estimates given it by Eusebio MUJAL, Secretary-General of the CTC. The Department gave it as its confidential opinion that Mujal's estimates are quite accurate approximations and that the actual member of the CTC must be regarded as very close to the 1,336,900 claimed.

The Department suggested, again confidentially, that the following membership figures would be more accurate in the case of the unions mentioned:

Construction Workers	75,000 net 150,000
Railway Brotherhood	25,000 net 28,000
Wheat Flour Processing	
Workers	20,000 net 30,000
Metallurgical Workers	16,000 net 35,000

In the case of the Maritime Workers, according to the International Department, the estimate is too low:

Maritime Workers	35,000 net 28,000

The net balance would reduce the CTC total membership to 1,236,000, or just about 1,200,000 that the CTC has previously claimed as its membership.

It may well be speculated whether in a country of a population of 6,000,000 and a labor force of about 2,000,000 there could be a trade union movement of well over 1,000,000. Notwithstanding, and considering each of the memberships claimed by the individual federations, as well as bearing in mind that in the predominant sugar industry the workers are in fact virtually all organized, the conclusion must

be that the figure of 1,336,900 members claimed by the CTC can be only moderately inflated and especially so by comparison with the inflation of union membership figures that is common in all, advanced as well as backward, parts of the world, and especially in Latin America.

Where in the attached table the Embassy has used the term "component unions", "local uniens" or "locals" might have served quite accurately. In some cases, however, as for example in the case of the Electric Plant Workers, the "component uniens" are called Provincial Federations. They do in fact carry out the functions of locals in the United States. Accordingly, the "national federations" may with a high degree of accuracy be regarded as what we should call in the United States national (or international) unions and the "component unions" as locals.
