of Nevember 9 listing the principal debts of the company which include an item of some \$1,900,000 to the Compania Gubena de Electriciaed, which Clark's ruling prevents him from paying off in current instalments in the absence of special authorization; and pointing out that under the moretorium law only 1 percent is paid on bonds and obligations instead of 5 and 5-1/2 percent, respectively, but that if the company fails to meet the 1 percent payments, the higher percentage rate will fall due and claim for immediate payment of the principal may also be made.
