The subject of verbal attacks on the Batista regime has been treat in each of this Embassy's WEEKAS since November 5, 1956. The vitriolic press and radio campaign began shortly after the slaying of ten Cubans in the Haitian Embassy, Habana, and still continues substantially unabated, Decument particularly via radio station HIT and the newspaper El Caribe. It is not believed indicative of any intention on the part of Trujillo to intervene militarily in the present Cuban fracas, but is considered an ന attempt, directed by him personally, to reap maximum propaganda benefits both at home and abroad from Batista misdeeds and Cuban turmoil. There is, therefore, nothing ¢, new in the specific attack cited in the Department's telegram. 0 Reti The person referred to by the Department as "Dr. Victor ESPINOSA Orjojo" is the mercenary penman Sixto Espinosa Orozco, a specialist int diatribe and part time philosopher imported from Spain about a year age for El Caribe and HIT. For his part in the Dominican editorial treatment of the Galindez affair see this Embassy's despatch No. 503 dated June 4, 1956. Ś **Ο** Espinosa visited the United States early this year. In an inter-0 view preceding the issuance of his visa he told the reporting officer that he was a militant anti-communist, having had two brothers killed by Communists during the Spanish Civil War. He professed great admira-I tion for the United States, comparing, in the fashion of many Spaniards, \square our position today vis-a-vis communism with that of Spain against the Ŵ Muslims in the fifteenth century. On his return from the United States his praise for the beauty of Washington was much greater than is usual for a Madrileno, bordering on adulation.
