Reliable source reports Jorge Ricardo Masetti, recent visitor to Cairo described by press as Director of Cuban News Agency PRENSA LATINA, was entrusted by Fidel Castro with task of exchanging confidential views with Nasser. Masetti saw Nasser May 13 and according source conveyed message to effect Castro had followed Egyptian revolution with great interest and admiration and that he has in mind doing in Latin American what Nasser has done in Middle East. Originally Castro had thought of being cooperative with Soviets but Nasser's experience with Communists and stand he forced take against US have caused Castro change mind. In reply Nasser gave Masetti full account his difficulties with Soviets.
