The Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs and Worship reiterates what it said on this U) matter to the Charge d'Affaires of the United States to the effect that the Government of the Dominican Republic finds itself animated by the best disposition to reciprocate fully every sincere proposition of the Government of Cuba to improve its relations with the Dominican Government."
