No objections declassify list of names in Embassy telegram 531 with statement source was GODR.

Embassy reluctant give blanket clearance release of pertinent information from subsequent messages on same subject. These messages contain considerable information of classified nature and Embassy would wish to know specifically what Department desires release. No objection however to mentioning Gomez Cacha told Embassy officers David Chervony killed while participating in invasion and Daniel Chervony was left behind in Cuba (Embassy telegram 80).
