he was being misled by those surrounding him who were keeping information from him as to the dangerous consequences of his increasing tendency toward illegal and unconstitutional action. He subsequently submitted his resignation, ostensibly as "a matter of delicacy." As a result of all the unfavorable publicity, Grau is now in a dilemma since the general public feels that he should not accept the resignation. On the other hand, he does not wish to continue Cruz as his Minister of Justice because of the latter's actions in connection with this matter. Hence he has not done anything.

No formal action has yet been announced on the resignation although an item appearing in The Havana Post of June 13 mentioned that it would be accepted and that Auténtico Senator Diego Vicente TELERA would be appointed to fill the vacancy.
