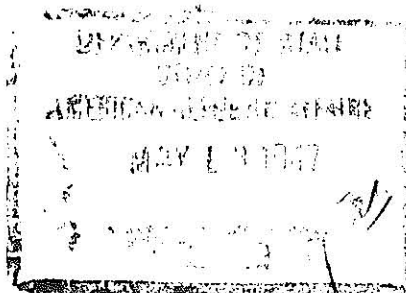

José L. VILABOY, Director of the Habana daily newspaper Mañana is planning a visit to the United States, and has expressed a desire to interview the American author Louis FISCHER. Vilaboy plans to leave Habana around May 20, and will be in New York a few days later, exact date unknown. As a gesture of cooperation the Journalists' Liaison Unit of the International Press and Publications Division in New York is respectfully asked to arrange such an interview, once señor Vilaboy communicates with it. Vilaboy edits a relatively unimportant newspaper which is strongly anti-Communist. He is going to the United States on a combined business and pleasure trip.
