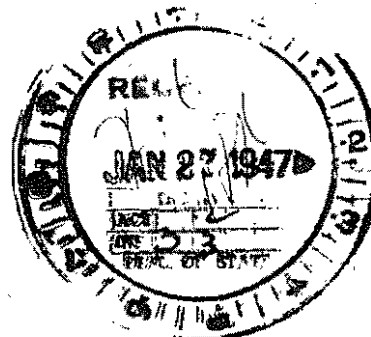

Warren Pine, General Manager in Habana for Pan American and Compania Cubana, informs the Commercial Attaché that Vice Marshall Bennett, who is here on behalf of the British Government to negotiate a bi-lateral civil aviation agreement with Cuba, informed him that the British planned a London-Canada-Nassau-Cuba-British Honduras-Balboa service, with another to Kingston, Jamaica, direct from Nassau. They plan to use four-engine Lancasters or Yorks. The Vice Marshall informed Pine as regards their communications that they plan to use portable radar sets which they could set up at the various airports.
