

Batista in the Senate

Following his return to Cuba on November 20 after more than four years of voluntary exile, former President Fulgencio BATISTA yesterday occupied the seat in the Senate to which he had been elected by the Liberal-Democratic Coalition on June 1. He entered the Senate Chamber in the company of Senators BRIGHTDIR (Independent) and BLANCO Torres (Republican) and was in ediately and enthusiastically greeted by Senator SUARCZ Rivas, head of the Liberal Senatorial Committee, and Senator Guas INCLAN (Liberal). The Vice President, ALONGO Pujol, who was in the chair, velcomed Batista and expressed cordial greetings and wishes for the success of his legislative activities. Batista, replying very briefly, expressed his thanks to the Vice President and at the same time greeted all the Senators present.
