I, S. B. HILLBROUCH, do hereby certify that I am a Deputy Sheriff of Dade County, Florida, and was on June 24, 1958, at which time I arrested one JUAN ALEJANDRO MILEN DELGADO, a/k/a Juan Melean, at Apartment 107 of the Suncoast Building of the Trade Winds Apartment Hotel at 2315 Pine Tree Drive, Miami Beach, Florida.

On June 24, 1958, while acting in my capacity as a Deputy Sheriff of Dade County, I served a State of Florida, Dade County search warrant at the aforesaid location (rooms 106 and 107).

Upon approaching these two rooms I found one JUAN ALEJANDRO MILEN DELGADO, a/k/a Juan Melean, standing in front of the door of Room 107. I asked him for permission to search Rooms 106 and 107. He declined this permission. Then I presented him with the warrant, made a search of the two rooms, and found therein:

> 9 cases of 40% extra Dupont dynamite 2 Thompson sub-machine guns 3 Rifles 1 45-cal. automatic pistol Small quantity of ammunition

JUAN ALEJANDRO MILEN DELGADO, a/k/a Juan Melean, was questioned there at the time the aforesaid ammunition was found, and he admitted that he was the occupant of Apartment 107 and had been living and sleeping there for several weeks.

Upon interrogation of JUAN ALEJANDRO MILEN DELGADO, a/k/a Juan Melean, as to his identify, it was found that he is a citizen of the Republic of Cuba, presently residing in Miami, Florida; and it was further found that he was one of the participants in the American Motor Vessel PHILOMAR expedition to Cuba. (This case is also known as Gesar Vega, et al)

AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT

Before me, <u>J. J. GORDON</u>, one of the Circuit Judges of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, In and For the County of Dade, personally appeared S. B. Billbrough, a Metropolitan Deputy Sheriff of Dade County, Florida, who first being duly cautioned and sworn according to law, upon his oath deposes and says that he, S. B. Billbrough, the affiant, has received reliable information from an informant that explosives, machine guns, weapons and ammunition are stored at a certain premises described as follows:

Apartment #106 of the Sun Coast Building of the Trade Winds Hotel Apartments located at 2315 Pine Tree Drive, Miami Beach, Dade County, Florida; said building being a two-story concrete block, stucco, flat-roofed building, painted white except for green trim extending from the ground upward approximately three feet, and except for planting bins and other trim of brown decorative stone. Above the doorway in the center of this building may be seen a yellow Neon sign containing the words "2315 Pine Tree Drive." Above this near the roof may be seen a green Neon sign containing the words "Trade Winds_Hotel Apartments."

Apartment #106 is located in the northwest section of this building. It has a glass jalousie door which is entered from Pine Tree Drive and has metal frame windows. Approximately 10 feet in front of this doorway a small printed sign approximately 1' x 2' has been placed in the lawn and bears the following words in white lettering "Nopise" and "Elcesei." Inside attached to the east wall of what appears to be the living room may be seen a large blue and white striped flag with a red triangle pointed down, containing a white star.

The affiant further states that this informant has observed the described premises almost constantly during the past 30 days, and on numerous occasions prior to that time, and has observed a number of white males carrying into the above described premises boxes resembling the appearance of those used to package explosives and dynamite.

The affiant further states that the informant on these occasions

has observed white males carrying packages which resembled those used to carry machine guns, rifles, and ammunition, and in fact did actually contain these weapons.

Further, the affiant states that the informant has actually observed explosives, machine guns, rifles, ammunition and other weapons in the above described premises.

And the affiant therefore does have good reason to believe, and does believe, that the aforesaid premises are being used unlawfully for the purpose of illegal possession and storage of explosives, machine guns, rifles, ammunition and other weapons, contrary to the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Florida.

Wherefore, affiant prays that a search warrant be issued according to law.
