SUBJECT: ALLEGED TRAFFIC IN FIREARMS

On July 22, 1958 the writer contacted Norman Ott, Route 2, Box 292, Homestead, CI 7-6888 with reference to information regarding unlawful possession and stopege of arms and ammunition on the property of Murry Sandler, located on West side of Tennessee Road, approximately 200 yards North of the intersection with Hainlin Drive.

Mr. Ott related that on July 6, 1958, Jan Williams, W/M from Homestead, while on a business visit at the Sandler estate noticed two males and one female of apparent Latin origin discharging firearms that were loaded in the back of a pick-up truck. The informant also stated that the arms used were stored in a house on the South West end of the property occupied by a George Carlstrom, W/M, 58 years.

The writer questioned Carlstrom about the presence of the firearms and Carlstrom stated that on the above mentioned date, three friends of Murray Sandler, leasee of the property did the shooting. All three persons involved were Cubans and Carlstrom believes that one of them operates a beauty parlor in Miami Beach. The names of the Cubans were unknown.

An empty cartridge found in the vicinity of the South West end of the Sandler property indicates t that the rifles used were 7.65 m.m. model 1938 Italian rifle.

During the conversation, the writer inspected the premises and noticed that there were no arms or ammunition stored in the house.

Paul Broeker, whose property adjoins that of Sandlers on the North and West side, related that he had heard some shooting but saw no movement of arms. He also related that Sandlers caretaker, by the name of McCall, had assaulted and beaten his sister Elizabeth when caught trespassing on the night of Thursday, July 17, 1958. Miss Broeker stated that she intends to press charges against McCall.

A background investigation on Sandler revealed that the subject has a long criminal record (see attached copy) and has past worthless checks on several occasions. At the present time he is listed as president of the Stratten Mortgage Company, and he lives at 1985 Ixoria Road, Key Stone Point, North Miami, PL 1-5717.

The writer has reason to believe that at the present time, there are no arms or ammunition stored on the property under investigation, however, due to the vicinity of a landing strip for sprayer planes (approximately two miles) located on Quail Roost Drive from which arms could be flown, the vicinity is going to be kept under periodical surveillance.
