On August 4, 1958 Agents A. L. Tarabochia and R. Minervini contacted Mr. James Gallagher, 2445 S.W. 17 Street with reference to phone calls made by Cubans allegedly involved in revolutionary activities.

Mr. Gallagher stated that while he was having telephone conversations he would be often interrupted by Spanish speaking persons connected by the same party line.

Mr. Gallagher was unable to explain the character of these interruptions but he assumed that they were conspiratory.

Mr. Gallagher stated that recently his phone had been taken off the party line.
