New York. May 26 .- At the opening of the court this morning. Judge Pailling, senior counsel for Addison Farusworth, Charles A. Walters, Wm. S. Lyster, Antrey, J. Morrison, John Crushton, and George R. Hall, the alleged flibusters, moved that these persons charg.d with violation of the neutrality laws, in setting 0.1 feet an armed expedition against the territory of Nicaragna, be discharged, by reason of a future on the part of the government to bring the industment pendmy against them, on for trial. Mr McKeon, district attorney, stated to the court that he was unable to procure his witursses, and he was therefore unitle to proceed against them. The court thereupon ordered

their discharge.
