Digp. -- On last Monday, Colonel A 1 Rudler, a well known cutten of Anguala died at the Hot Springs in Arkanses Coland Rudler was the friend and company lun in arms of the great filibusterer tiener al Wm. Walker He accompanied Walk. or in both of his trips to Nicaragua, and was his second in command of the last expedition. His great nerve and fine milifary abilities were conspicuously displayed in both campaigns. When the last invasion resulted so disastronaly, he and Walker were both captured, and both sentenced to be shot. The efforts of Colonel Rudler's friends in this country, however, effeted his pardon and release. In 1861 he entered our army and served with dis-

thetion as a Colonel. He had been in bad health for some time previous to his death.—Chronicle and Sentinel, 11th.
