## WAS A NATIVE OF LOUISVILLE.

Capt. T. W. Lund, Mayor of Titusville, Fla., Succumbs To Paralysis.

Capt. Thomas W. Lund, Mayor of Titusville, Fla., died at the home of his son, in Jacksonville, last Monday as the result of a stroke of paralysis.

Capt. Lund was a native of Louisville, having been born in this city in 1831. He was a teamboatman, and began his career on the Mississippi river. He opened up a line of steamers on St. John's river in Florida as far as Poinsett. He amassed a considerable fortune and was one of the most substantial and highly-respected citizens of Titusville. At the time of his death he was Vice President of the Titusville Board of Trade, as well as Mayor of the city. Besides his wife and two grown children, he leaves a sister, Mrs. Roberts, of Louisville.
