NOTE.

Just before closing the printing of the Minutes, the following Resolution was handed me by the Chairman of the Committee on Foreign Correspondence, which was adopted by the Grand Lodge as a portion of the report of that Committee:

Resolved, That the Subordinate Lodges under the jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of Georgia be instructed not to Initiate, Pass or Raise any candidate who has not resided in the State of Georgia twelve calendar months before such application be made; and that the expediency and propriety of adopting a similar rule be earnestly recommended to our sister Grand Lodges of the United States, as being one means of preventing unworthy men gaining admission or access to the thresholds of our mystic temple.

LAFAYETTE LODGE, No. 44.—With regard to this Lodge, I would add, that since the Report was made, (as will be found in the minutes,) of its standing with the Grand Lodge, it has paid up part of its annual dues, and therefore its charter is not now subject to forfeiture.
