There is a very pretty little quarrel getting up in Kansas between Governor Geary and Judge Lecompte. It will be remembered that the Judge released on bail, one Hayes, a murderer, which so dissatisfied the Governor that he ordered Donaldson, the Marshal, to arrest Hayes. Upon Donaldson's refusal, he sent Col. Titus, who took Haves and shut him up in prison. The Governor is determined that he shall be tried, and the Judge that he shall be released on bail. The counsel for Hayes is resolved to test the fact whether the Governor has any right thus to interfere with judicial proceedings, and will at once move for a writ of habeas corpus which Lecompte will at once grant. The attempt to execute it will be resisted by the Governor, and then there will be some fun. Donaldson has resigned to prevent being turned out, and there is a late report that Geary has backed out. and released the murderer on bail, finding the slavery party too powerful for him.
