Article VIII. The code of regulations

governing this treaty shall be printed

by the consul, with the cooperation of

the American citizens; and they, the said

authorities and consuls, shall be enabled

to introduce any future regulations which

may be found necessary in order to give

effect to the objects of this treaty.

All fines and penalties inflicted for

infractions of the previous regulations of

this treaty shall be paid to the

Siamese government.

Article IX. The American government

shall have the right to send to the

Siamese government, and vice versa, any

participation in any privileges that

may have been or may hereafter be granted

by the Siamese government to the

consular, citizens, or subjects of any

nation.

Article X. After the lapse of ten years

from the date of the ratification of this

treaty, upon the desire of either the

American or Siamese government, and on

twelve months' notice given by either party,
