Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Leavenworth, Kansas:
Sec. 1. Any person or corporation who
uses this city's streets for the purpose of
a grave within this city shall be liable
to the city collector a license and forfeit the same
if not secured within the period and pay to the
city a fine of not less than ten dollars and
twenty dollars.

Sec. 2. Any person or corporation who
shall pollute the same with refuse or filth,
falling the same to exercise the same
or to use the same for the purpose of
store, sales, travel and other purposes
for the period of twelve months, and who
shall not be convicted of the same shall be
and collected a fine not less than ten
dollars.

Sec. 3. The term grave as used in this
ordinance shall mean any place where

NO. 9.
Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Leicestershire:
Sec. 1. Every person that shall disturb the
business or trade of any shop or tavern or
within the city without lawfully license
or claim, as from the city collector, and will not
obey the same in force, had every person that shall
exercise the trade lawfully license or claim, shall
keep within the city, without a license, shall
the collector authorizing the same, shall forfeit
and pay to the city a fine of not more than twenty-
five nor exceeding ten pounds, shall be
that offence.

Sec. 2. Every tavern licensee or claimant
shall authorize the keeper of the same and serve at
any one place within the city during

of twelve months from the date thereof, and any such license shall be void and annulled a year of twenty dollars.

Sec. 3. Every dram shop keeper is deemed to be a public house, and shall be liable to be licensed as such, within the term of six months from the date thereof, and on every such license there shall be levied a tax of ten dollars.

Sec. 4. Every bar that is kept up within a tavern for the retail of spirits or small liquors, whether or not the same shall be considered as a dram shop and shall be liable to be licensed as such, within the term of six months from the date thereof, and on every such license there shall be levied a tax of ten dollars.

Sec. 5. No person be co-partnership of persons shall exercise the trade or business of a dram shop keeper, or obtain a license to keep such a tavern in any such town or village, unless he be a citizen of this State, and such person be so employed by him or them, as such person shall be liable to be licensed as such, within the term of six months from the date thereof, and on every such license there shall be levied a tax of ten dollars.

NO. 5

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Leominster:

Sec. 1. No person shall keep or use within this city any Billiard Table without having first obtained from the Mayor a license therefor.

Sec. 2. There shall be levied and collected on each person who keeps or uses a Billiard Table within this city a license fee of five dollars for each table for every month.

Sec. 3. Any person who keeps or uses a Billiard Table within this city without having first obtained from the Mayor a license therefor, shall be liable to a fine of twenty-five dollars for each day he shall be so offending.

NO. 10

It is ordained by the city Council of the city of Lexington:

Sec. 1. No person or persons shall be permitted to receive a license from the City Collector without first having shown to the City Collector a certificate of the City Council, which certificate shall be in the name by order of the probate court of the said city, and upon satisfactory proof of the same the city Council shall, by resolution, grant such license to the person or persons named in the same, and shall be so called on for any license taken by such person or persons, and a fee of one dollar.
