News from Kansas. St. Lous, Oct. 2, 1856. A letter to the *Republican*, dated Lecompton, Sopt. 28, gires the following cheering intelligence:— The armed bands that have been anging through the Territory are dispersed—citizens are returning to their

claims—business is reviving—confidence is restored, and reace reigns throughout the Territory. Warrants have been issued for the arrest of Messrs. Joses, Striegfellow, and other pro-shavery agitators. Goy. Geary has appointed Col. Titus to form a routneer battsino to proserve the peace in the neighborhood of Lecompton, and has awarded the same duty to Capt. Walker in the

vicinity of Lawrence.
