St. Louis, Oct. 2

A letter to the Republican, dated Leecompton, 26th ult., says armed bands of dispersed citizens are returning to their claims, but peace generally reigns throughout the Territory. Business is reviving and confidence restored.

Warrants have been issued for Jones and Stringfellow, and other pro-slavery agitators.

Geary has appointed Col. Titus to form volunteer battalions to preserve peace in the neighborhood of Leecompton, and Capt Walker upon the same duty for the vicinity of Lawrence.
