A letter from our Greytown correspondent which we publish to-day, while it gives some curious details of the fillibuster expedition up the San Juan, throws great doubts on the reported successes of Lichridge in the capture of the post at Sarapiqui, However that may be, it is certain that so far as robbery and plunder is concerned, on the small scale within their power, these fillibusters have done just what might be expected of Col. Titus and his Border Ruffians. So far as relates to robbing Indians and stealing plantaics. Titus and his men will doubtless do good service.
