Two weeks ago Mr. Alfredo Capero of Channel 23, in Miami was here to interview me for a special program about the Cuban political prisoners in the U.S., Venezuela and Mexico.

During the conversation we discussed the fact that the liberal press (mainly the N.Y. Times & the Washington Post) were instrumental in presenting a false image about me and our Cuban Nationalist Movement to the American public in spite of a guilty conviction against us for the killing of Marxist Chilean Orlando Letelier, in Washington.

Mr. Capero spoke to me about your "AIM-Report" and was kind enough to mail me your publication of June II, 1980.

He wrote to me saying that if I wrote to you, perhaps you would be kind enough to add my name to your mailing list for the "AIM Report".

Permit me to congratulate you on the brilliant exposing of the traitor Phillip Agee and of the "works" of the PBS in respect to "On Company Business."

Public Broadcasting Service (I have heard many of their radio editorials) seems to be giving a "Service" against the American "Public", rather than serving the values and interests of this nation.
