'Anti-Cuban hysteria' in the United States led to the bombing at the UN Cuban Mission Saturday, the official Soviet news agency, Tass, said Sunday. The explosion in a trash container blew out a side door of the mission and shattered windows. Two policemen were treated for cuts and bruises. After the blast, a caller told several news organizations that a group called Omega Seven was responsible. Tass called the group "terrorists" who "help whip up in the country anti-Cuban hysteria, which underlies the official political course of the Washington administration."
