3 Hurt by Time Bomb

NEW YORK—Anti-Castro terrorists slipped past a 24-hour police guard at the Cuban mission to the United Nations and planted a powerful time bomb that injured a policeman, a mission guard and a man on the other side of E. 67th Street.

The bomb in the mission doorway blew out scores of windows, wrecked a number of parked cars and dug a two-foot crater in the sidewalk between Madison and 5th Avenues.

An hour after the explosion, a caller to United Press International said the bombing was carried out by Omega 7, a right-wing terrorist group of Cuban exiles.
