Now Know De, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Henry J. Tims,

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Henry I, Titus, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
