

# Seven Indicted For Lynching

## Thirteen Men Now Accused of Inciting Mob Which Lynched Negroes

Duluth, Minn., July 13—Seven indictments were returned late today by a special grand jury investigating the recent lynching of three negroes here. Two of the men named in the indictment were arrested charged with inciting riot. The other five named have not yet been taken into custody. Six indictments previously had been returned in connection with the lynching.

A. W. Murnlan, commissioner of public safety said tonight that he would not resign his office despite a report today by the grand jury denouncing his department. The grand jury's report said that "Murnlan is not competent" to hold office and expressed the belief that he was "responsible for a condition that existed within the police department on June 15," when the three negroes were lynched.
